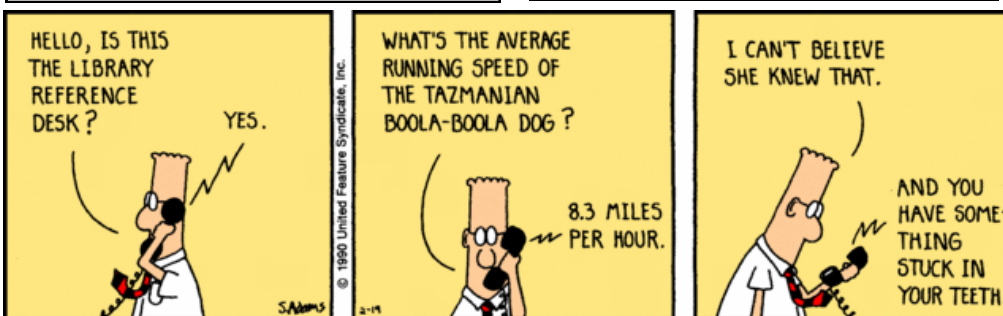
## BICENTENNIAL COOKBOOK

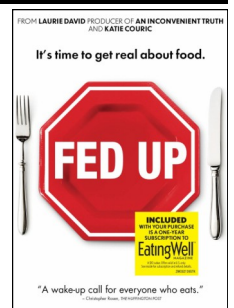
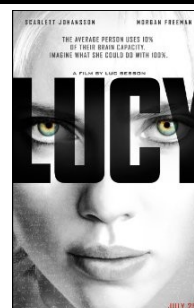
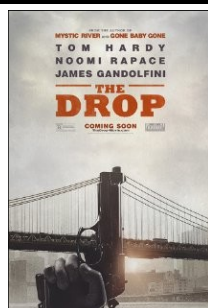
## COMPUTER CLASSES
