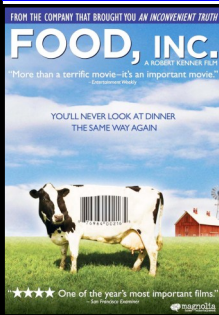

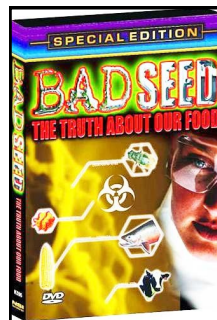


March 10, 12:30P - **FOOD, INC** -

choices.

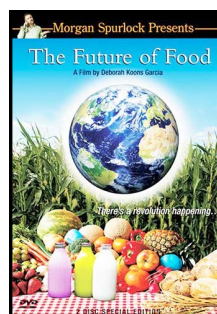
