LIBRARY NEWS



First of all, a most generous couple of friends of the library have made challenge to the township: they will match donations up to \$500 for improvements to the necessary repairs of the library building. (see below)

The story book hour (12 Noon-1PM on Saturdays) hosted by Elaine Sink has been a great success. This program will continue for eight weeks. It may continue beyond the eight weeks, if popular. Look for information in this newsletter as time goes by. The only weekend that is excluded is June 19th when the **Library Yard and Garden Sale** and **Glennie Auto Show** take place. Look for information on the Auto Show in the Glennie-Curtisville Newspaper.

The library is applying for a USDA American Reinvestment & Recovery Act grant to:

- Expand the library parking lot
- Build overhangs over the front and side doors of the library to protect them from the elements and replace the rusting steel doors
- Buy the remaining steel high-capacity shelving to replace the old wood shelving making our library viable well into the 21st century

The library (thanks to Moira Maus, Elaine, George and Chastity McNamara, intrepid rock collectors) has created a butterfly garden at the western side of the front library grounds. Thanks also to Christopher Clouse of Glennie Ace Hardware who donated the rocks and Moira, who donated the plants, we have a butterfly garden. If you check out the website: www.curtistownship.org, you can see the details of the garden and a list of the plants that you would need to build your own butterfly garden.

For those of you who have noticed that the library flag has not flown for a while, the halyard (rope) has finally rotted away after 12 years and we have ordered a replacement. That will require specialized high-rise equipment and negotiations are under way to obtain that equipment.

The Glennie Friends of the Library have donated \$200 to purchase new DVD's for the library since that is the most popular section of the library lending activity. Look for new selections soon.




