2011 Grant Writing Plans

We are currently working on several fundraising projects to improve library services for our community.

- **Shelving Project:** \$28,000 is the projected cost to replace the old wooden shelves with the taller black shelving units. Funds we've raised thus far:
 - \$1500 from the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan (CFNEM)
 - \$300 from Joanne & Claude Noe
 - \$40 misc. community donation
 - Funding requests are being sent to private foundation
- **Summer Programming** — \$3000 requested from CFNEM
- **Downloadable Audios** — \$500 requested from CFNEM
- **Accessibility Grant** — \$3000 to private foundations for large type computer keyboards, magnifying bars, & electric door opener
