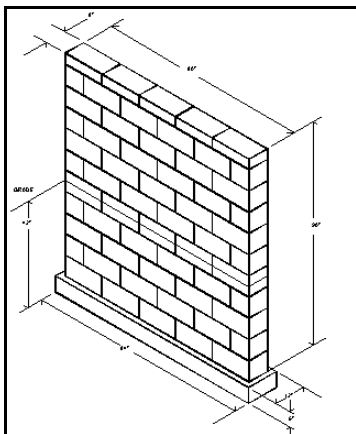
THE SIGN IS FALLING!

As you can see our building sign is falling down. We need to replace it this fall before the snow flies. We've managed to accumulate all the

materials (donated by generous friends) to build a masonry sign (smaller than the one we have now— but large enough to do the job). We've found a person to dig the hole. Another person has already built the foundation form. But now we need a person or persons to pour the 42" deep foundation (about 7 cubic feet of concrete) and then build the concrete block wall as shown on the right. The wall is only 7 feet long and about 48" above the ground. It's an easy job for the folks who do masonry work. Time is getting short. 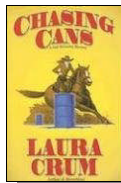

By Rett MacPherson

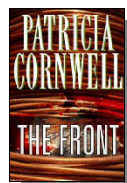

By Laura Crum

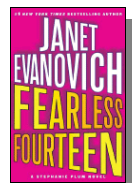

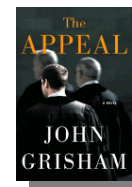
