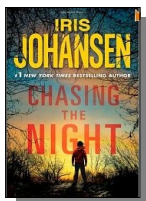

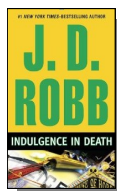

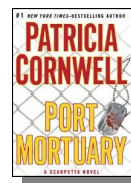
**Chasing The Night** by Iris Johansen

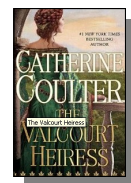
