

#### GRANTS

The Robert C. Reinhart Grant application is in the works and still has not given us word as of the October newsletter. That could be \$25,000 in the library's survival fund. It would go a long way for us.

The United States Department of Agriculture has tentatively approved a partial grant for the new canopies over the front doors and the side door of the library to help keep the ravages of weather off of the doors that have suffered as well as the parking lot expansion.



There are two other grants in the works from the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan for more DVD shelving (\$3000) as well as audio books (\$500).

We are applying for a Broadband Technology Opportunity Project grant. If accepted, we would be getting 3 new computers in 2011.


All of the services at the library are free but donations are appreciated especially these days when state and federal aid are dwindling. Try to remember your library when you are planning your estate as well.




## COMING TO THE LIBRARY IN OCTOBER




by **Lost Empire**
