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The Negaunee Public Library's Summer Reading Programs begin Monday, June 10! There's something for all ages.

Children age 3 and up can register to participate and pick up a book of their choice and a reading log to track the time they spend reading on or after June 10. There will be prizes and special events throughout the program, culminating in an ice cream social for the finale party at 2 p.m. Tuesday, July 30.
