**Mobile Web Page for Libraries Website**

There are a couple approaches to doing this

1. If you are using a Joomla site you can add the jMobile module to the website and maybe another extension so then when mobile devices are used and pointed to your site it will detect it and show the mobile site. I will write more documentation on using this extension for libraries that are currently using Joomla.
  
2. The next option would be to create a mobile website. A lot of libraries do this and have a link to it from their website or use a java script to detect mobile device and have it redirect to the site. To create this site you can use different products:
